DELINQUENT FEES:

Delinquent Notice Fee:	\$5.00	Charged to all accounts unpaid after 30 days A billing statement will be mailed to the premises
2nd Delinquent Notice Fee:	\$20.00	Charged to accounts unpaid after 60 days A 2nd billing statement will be mailed to the premises and/or known mailing address
3rd Delinquent Notice Fee:	\$50.00	Charged to all accounts unpaid after 75 days A delinquent statement will be mailed to the premises and/or known mailing address via certified, return receipt mail and regular mail
4th Delinquent Notice Fee:	\$80.00	Charged to all accounts unpaid after 90 days for which it has been determined the premise is not vacant A notice will be posted at the premise stating that the water will be shut off in 5 days if payment not received
Water Shut Off or Turn on Fee:	\$50.00	Fee charged for water to be turned off or on
Lien Filing Fee:	\$400.00	Charged to all accounts unpaid after 145 days to cover District costs to file a tax lien with the county
Certified Mail Fee:	\$50.00	Charged to customer when any certified mail is sent

Tap Repair Inspection	\$600	<i>If repair must be performed using district mains for access, additional charges will be assessed for district costs incurred to monitor access and condition of district facilities after the repair</i>
Trenchless Tap Repair Inspection	\$400	<i>If repair must be performed using district mains for access, additional charges will be assessed for district costs incurred to monitor access and condition of district facilities after the repair</i>
Emergency Tap Repair Inspection	\$850	<i>If repair or inspection are performed with less than 48 hour notice</i>
Emergency Tap Repair After Hours Inspection	\$200/hr	<i>If repair or inspection are performed with less than 48 hour notice and after normal business hours</i>
